I beg to submit the Parks and Cemeteries report for the year 1942.

ST. GEORGE'S ISLAND AND ZOO:

Six new picnic tables were added this year and there is now ample accommodation for picnic parties.

The water system was extended by 200 feet.

The Zoo continues to be a great attraction with big attendances on Sundays and Holidays.

All pens and cages were well maintained, painted and repaired when necessary.

PARKS:

There was very little new work done on the parks this year, our activities being confined mostly to maintenance work.

Additions were made to the water system at South Calgary Park.

A border was made all round Crescent Park ready for planting next year and a water system was installed.

Provision was made in the estimates for improvements to the north bank of the Bow River and the area south of the Elbow River. This work was not done.

GOLF COURSE:

The water service (commenced in 1941) was completed this year.

The mens' fairways numbers 1 to 7 and the ladies' fairway number 7 were top dressed and should show an improvement by next season.

The bridge across the gully has never been painted and should be done in 1943.

The Course was well attended, the number of games played being 20,921

MEWATA STADIUM & HILLHURST PARK:

The grandstand needs repainting and the dressing roof leaks. This should have attention.

The running track is in poor condition and needs a layer of about 10 loads of shale.

The Stadium was used on 79 occasions for games, sports meetings, etc.

There were no senior rugby games played and the average gate percentage receipts were small.

PLAYGROUNDS: (Cont'd)

The usual playground activities, softball, paddle tennis, gymnastics, sewing, basket weaving, reed and wood work were carried on.

Twice a week registered playground attendants were permitted to attend the Mewata Swimming Pool free of charge and were given swimming and diving instructions by the pool attendants. 2,654 children took these lessons.

The usual sports meeting at the Stadium was not held this year. Instead a gala gathering was held at Bowness Park with an attendance of approximately 1,000 children and parents.

MEWATA SWIMMING POOL:

The pool was painted before opening, new lockers and diving board were installed.

The sod of the boulevard at the entrance was removed and replaced with crushed gravel, and the north and south ends round the pool (which were bare earth) were concreted. This work was necessary as the dirt was being carried into the pool.

BOULEVARDS:

The cost of tree removals was \$3,312.83 for taking out 322 trees. The amount provided in the estimates for this work was only \$2,000.00. As there is an increasing demand for tree removals owing to sewer trouble, an appropriation of at least \$3,500.00 should be provided in next year's estimates.

CEMETERIES:

Queen's Park: The erection of the service building was postponed, but the work of laying out the burial ground, roadways, grass areas, planting of trees, shrubs and flower beds was proceeded with as far as possible. There were 265 burials in this Cemetery during the year, mostly in single grave plots. There will be a big increase in these figures during 1943 as the double grave section in Burnsland Cemetery is nearly full.

St. Mary's Cemetery (Extension) Improvements to the entrance were made by erecting an entrance gate, altering the driveway and re-arranging the shrubbery and flower beds.

NURSERIES:

For use in the parks, cemeteries, boulevards, etc., 2,395 trees, 3,690 shrubs, 18,206 perennial plants and 4,185 bulbs were provided from nursery stock.

Fresh plantings were made of trees, shrubs and plants in all available space to provide for future requirements.

WORKSHOP:

The workshop staff did all the repair work necessary to motor scythes, motor and hand mowers, playground apparatus, tools, park furniture, etc.

A large quantity of tools and spare parts were destroyed by fire in September and we may not be able to replace some of the spare parts for the duration of the war.
