

MAX Orange and Teal shelters exhibit select works from the City of Calgary's Public Art Collection. Each work represents a unique perspective of an artist who has resided in Calgary at some point in their lives. Works featured range in age from 80 years old to art created in this decade, and are created by many artists who live here or have lived here. The City of Calgary's Public Art Collection has been built over the last century thanks to the generosity of Calgarians and local organizations, such as the Calgary Allied Arts Foundation.

The two oldest pieces of art featured in MAX shelters are both from 1938: The first is called Old Shed, Sunalta by artist Jim Nicoll; the second is titled Memorial Drive East of Centre by Douglas Motter. Artist Chris Flodberg created Opulence, the newest piece in the shelter exhibition, in 2011.
